



What is “mounting”?

Everything that is brought into be framed, will need some kind of mounting. It's what goes on behind a picture or under a mat that cannot be seen in a completed frame. However it can still impact design. Also the method chosen for mounting can make subtle changes to the overall appearance.

Mounting encompasses a long list of options, conservation and non-conservation techniques. For example conservation mounting is important for preserved art which is typically hinged instead of permanently mounted. This makes all the processes reversible so an item can be returned to its original condition.
